Mira Costa High School football games represent a long tradition of being an event where our community comes together on Friday night to cheer on our Mustangs. This Friday, September 19th, MCHS is excited to host its first home game of the 2025 season. Costa is an alcohol and drug free campus. Those in violation will be removed from the venue with no refund and at risk for additional consequences. The primary goals are the safety and comfort of all attendees at our games.

Please review the following EXPECTATIONS for Waller Stadium:

General Entry

- Tickets are available online via GoFan or by clicking <u>HERE</u>.
- Cash ticket purchases are available on game day starting at 6:00pm at the Peck ticketing entrance or the Meadows ticketing entrance to Waller Stadium.
- NO IN/OUT privileges at Varsity Football Games. Once you leave, there is no re-entry.
- NO outside food or drinks.
- Parents can enter with their own children only to the game. If a friend of their child would like to attend, they must be with their own parent(s).
- Parents/Adults are responsible for monitoring all students they bring to the game.

Student Expectations

- ASB Markers will allow you free admission to the game; however, you MUST present your school ID at the gate for entry. Screenshots of a school ID will NOT be accepted.
- All non-high school-age students must be accompanied by their own parent/adult.
- Only high school students from participating schools may attend the game. Students from non-participating schools must be accompanied by their own parent/adult.
- Students MAY NOT bring backpacks or large purses/bags into the stadium.

Spectator Expectations

- Respectful behavior towards all in attendance with the goal that everyone, especially visiting teams and their families, feel safe and welcome.
- For safety of all, DO NOT congregate on Stadium Way.
- Any students creating a disturbance and/or caught in non-approved areas will be directed to leave.
 - Consequences per the behavior/discipline matrix will be administered for any MCHS, MBMS or Hermosa
 USD student who does not abide by the rules. This may include being banned from future games.
 - o Students from other schools will be referred to their administration for discipline.
 - Resident and non-resident students who do not attend MCHS schools may be banned from future games as well.

Our overall goal and focus is to create a community experience where all attendees can enjoy the game. We look forward to upholding the MCHS tradition in a manner that is both positive and safe, reflecting the excellence of the Manhattan Unified School District.
