Law Enforcement Drill Notice

Dear Mokena Parent / Guardian,

The Illinois School Safety Drill Act requires that all public and private schools review their school safety plans with first responders and conduct specific school safety drills. The Act establishes the minimum requirements and standards for schools to follow when conducting school safety drills and reviewing school emergency and crisis response plans and to encourage schools and first responders to work together for the safety of children.

Law Enforcement - Within 90 days after the first day of each school year, schools must conduct a law enforcement drill to address a school shooting incident. Such drills are conducted according to our crisis response plan with the participation of the Mokena Police Department. Although we recommend that all students participate in our law enforcement drills, families have the opportunity to have their children opt out of the drill. Our first law enforcement drill was on Friday, Oct. 17th, and **our next drill will be this upcoming Monday, Jan. 12th**. If you have any questions about the drill or wish to opt your child out of the drill you may reach out to me directly.

While we hope to never have an emergency, if one occurs, we want our staff and students to be prepared. If you have questions about any of our safety drills please feel free to contact the office at 708-342-4870, or email me at munchlmokena159.org.

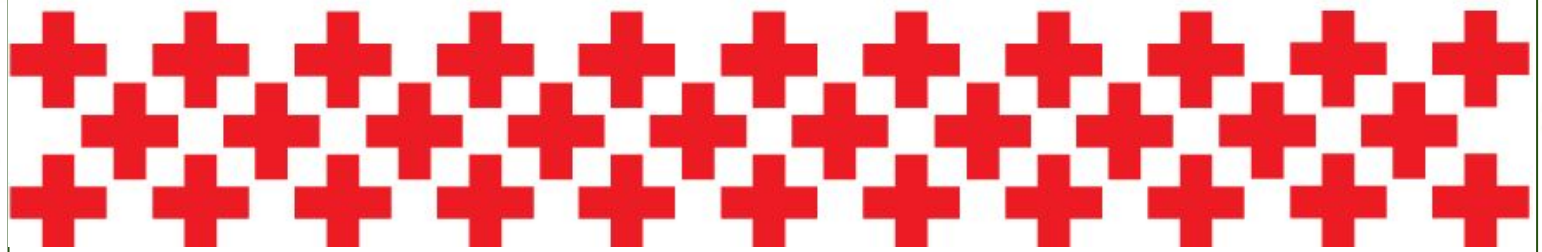

End of 2nd Quarter!

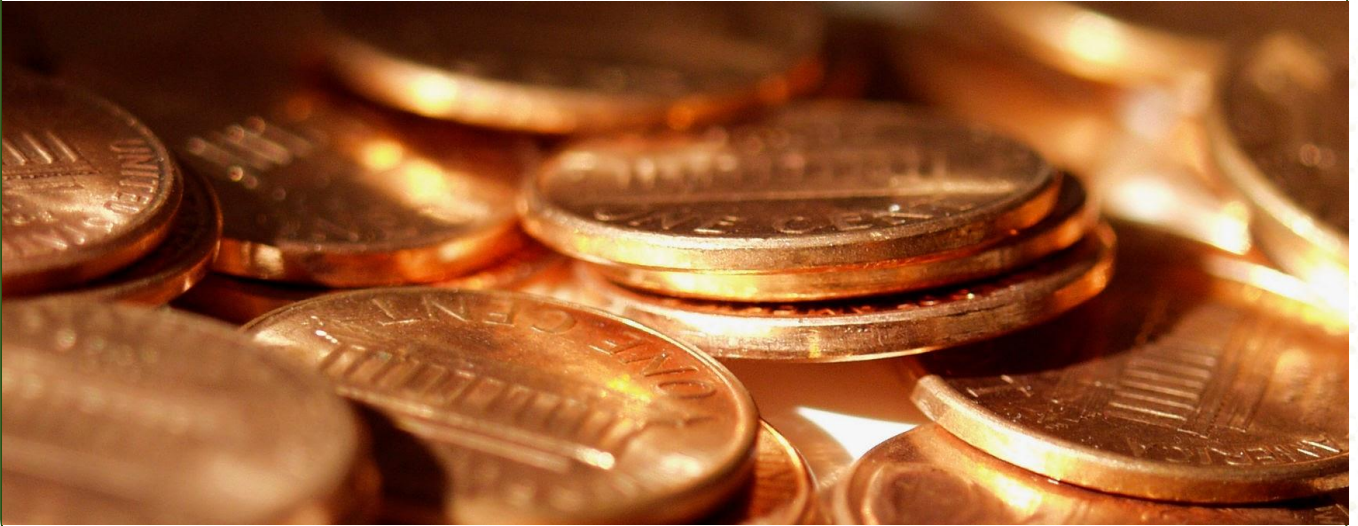
January 16th will mark the end of the 2nd quarter! Now would be an excellent time to check your child's grades and talk to them about finishing strong.
