- Children benefit and make the most of their educational opportunities if they attend school regularly and on time.






DISTANCE LEARNING DAY




OCTOBER 10, 2025

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



- . Follow the directions of the Forest Hill Traffic Team and Crossing Guard at all times.
- Observe the one-way signs in and out of the school at all times.
- Certain lanes are for daycare vans and buses. Signage will be clearly posted.
- Please refrain from talking on your cell phone or smoking in the carline.
- Each car will receive a dash tag to use when picking your child up in the carline.
- Turning out of the paring lot onto Moffett Road is <u>prohibited</u> during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up.
- Listen for the whistle: 2 short beeps= traffic moving/ NO UNLOADING
 1 long beep= UNLOAD CARS
- Please do not exit your car to retrieve your child. Children will be called, and the Forest Hill Traffic Team will help assist your child safely to his/ her vehicle.





No early dismissals are allowed after 2:00pm. Excessive early dismissals will be referred to the office of Early Warning Truancy. Parents picking students up for an early dismissal must show identification.



MCPSS does not allow schools to have birthday parties.
Students may bring in pre-packaged/ individually wrapped snacks or treat bags to pass out to their classmates.
Parents are not allowed to disrupt instructional time to pass anything out. No other party items are permitted such as: (balloons, sheet cakes, pizza, cupcakes, etc.).

SCHOOL SCHEDULE

ARRIVAL

Students SHOULD NOT arrive before 7:45am.
This includes walkers.

DISMISSAL



Early Dismissals ARE NOT permitted after 2:00pm. Those checking students out should arrive before 2pm AND PRESENT A VALID ID.





Cell phone usage by students during the school day causes a major disruption to the learning environment. Cell phones have become a distraction to student learning and are the cause of many disciplinary infractions, ranging from bullying to cheating. Therefore, we will enforce our policy in the Student Code of Conduct that states: "Students should avoid disrupting classroom activities by not displaying, using, or activating wireless communication devices during the school day." That includes cell phones, earbuds, and smart watches.

Cell phones <u>are not</u> permitted during school hours/ instructional time. It is imperative that your child follow the guidelines set forth in the district/ school cell phone usage policy.
