Notes from Guidance



ALL STUDENTS

On April 23rd and April 30th, all students in grades 9-12 will be receiving 45-minute, age appropriate, informative in-person presentations using lessons from the Safer Smarter Kids or Safer Smarter Teens curriculum. These videos are **REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION**. All students should make every effort to be in attendance during FLEX/HR on those dates. A make-up session for each grade level will be scheduled at a later date, but Seniors will not be cleared for graduation until they have attended both sessions. Please have your student make every effort to attend on these dates!



SENIORS

Any student who has enlisted in the military needs to come to the Guidance office and give their name and rank to Mrs. Gray no later than Friday, April 4th. Enlisted students are invited to attend the Military Recognition Event at Ft. Jackson in Columbia on Tuesday, May 13th. The district will provide transportation, but you must sign up by April 4th. Enlisted students will also receive cords to wear at graduation, so please give your name to Mrs. Gray so we can celebrate you!

- Seniors must arrive by 4:40 P.M. in their caps and gowns.

Graduation Dress Code

- Dresses and skirts should be white or black and school appropriate length.
- Dress pants should be white or black.
- Dress Shoes – no flip flops, slides, etc.
- A tie or bowtie is encouraged for the gentlemen.
- No decorating or altering of graduation attire or caps.
- Seniors not appropriately dressed will not be allowed to participate in Graduation.

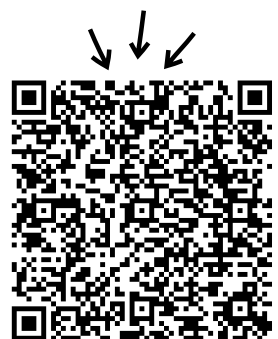
Receiving Diplomas

- Diplomas will be distributed to seniors immediately following the ceremony in the tunnel.
- Individual disruptions of any kind during the ceremony will result in having the diploma withheld until a conference is conducted with school administration, the parent, and the graduate.

Graduation Reminders

- No balloons, horns, banners, food, drinks, backpacks, or gifts will be allowed in the Coliseum.
- This is a solemn, formal occasion.
- Behavior and attitude should rise to fit the occasion.
- Parents and guests should remain seated and refrain from shouting, catcalls, and any other disorderly conduct.
- Graduates' personal belongings should be left with family members.

Fourth-period teachers will receive a list of qualifying students in their email. Please email Mrs. Paulhamus with any issues.

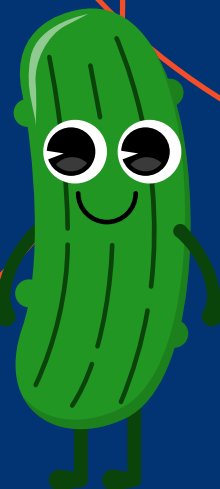
You will distribute wristbands to qualifying students during flex on Friday.

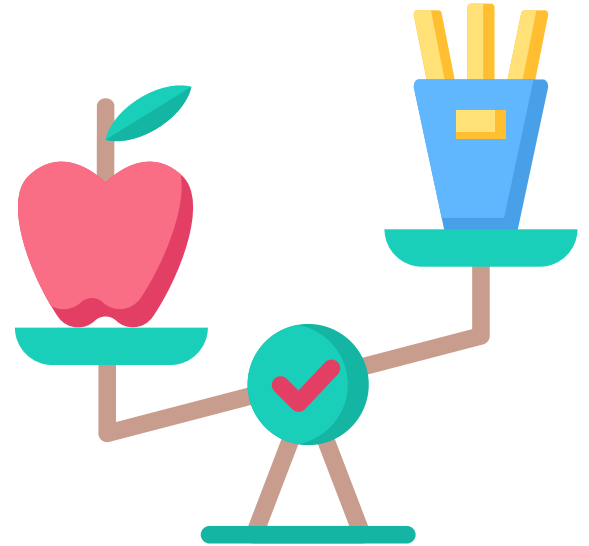

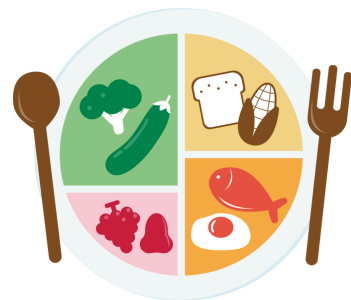
